1. Purpose:

To communicate the Governor's procedures for determining training program eligibility for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title I-B Individual Training Accounts and the state's Training Benefits (TB) program.

This revision updates content on the Governor's Procedures for Determining Training Program Eligibility around post-training minimum wage requirements.

2. Background:

WIOA Section 122 requires that Governors establish criteria, information requirements, and procedures for training programs in local areas that receive WIOA Title I-B adult and dislocated worker funds.

3. Policy:

Pursuant to action by the Workforce Training and Education Coordinating Board (WTECB) at its June 2, 2021 meeting and subsequently on November 7, 2024, eligibility of training programs to receive funds through WIOA Title I-B Individual Training Accounts and serve individuals in the state's Training Benefits (TB) program is determined via the procedures found in state policy:
