What: Wahkiakum Career Day

When: Wednesday, March 29, 2017, 1-3 p.m.

Where: Wahkiakum High School – Gymnasium, 500 South 3rd Street, Cathlamet, WA 98612

Who: 9th through 12th graders will meet businesses to learn about industries, jobs and

required skills so they can make decisions about their future education and careers.

- Prior to the 1-3 p.m. session with employers, Partners in Careers (PIC) will lead students through interviewing activities and discuss career resources.
- WorkSource will conduct mock interviews and review resumes.
- The school will provide tools to help students engage in conversations with the employers.

- Approximately 25 companies will participate
 - City of Longview will display two large pieces of equipment (a vacuum truck and a television inspection truck) outside the school's main entrance to give students a feel for what the water and sewer department does to maintain pipes. Inside the gym, students will be able to interact with a camera/robot.
 - Cathlamet Fire Department is bringing an ambulance.
 - Style Masters Academy will give curling and hair extension demonstrations on willing students and mannequins.
 - Wahkiakum Public Utilities District is bringing equipment used to climb poles and fix wires.
 - WorkSource will help students register on www.WorkSourceWA.com a job search portal where they can create and store resumes and applying for jobs.
