To apply for the apprenticeship program, an individual must be at least 18 years of age, have at least a 10<sup>th</sup> grade education and possess a valid driver's license.

Apprenticeship provides a combination of on-the-job experience, classroom and field training. Construction craft laborers work as part of a team that builds: highways, water mains, treatment plants, light rail systems, stadiums, airports, bridges, tunnels, factories and stores.
